### EMMANUEL MUSIC ANNOUNCES BACH CANTATA SERIES SCHEDULE SEPTEMBER – DECEMBER 2010

Ryan Turner, Artistic Director, has programmed Emmanuel Music's 2010-2011 Bach Cantata season, which begins on Sunday, September 26 with Mr. Turner conducting BWV 137, *Lobe den Herren*. The Cantatas are presented as part of the Sunday liturgy as Bach intended, at 10:00 AM on Sunday mornings at Emmanuel Church, 15 Newbury Street, Boston, where Emmanuel Music is the Ensemble-in-Residence. John Harbison, Principal Guest Conductor, and Michael Beattie, Artistic Administrator, will also conduct cantatas during the season.

Sunday September 26, 2010 also marks the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Emmanuel Church, with a special service. The full fall cantata schedule with soloists and guest artists is as follows:
